
#### **Fabric Requirements**

6 assorted dark colored fabrics for dots and crosses 1/2 yd. each

6 assorted medium colored fabrics for large print blocks

6 assorted light colored fabrics for background

Border: 1 1/2 yd. / Binding: 3/4 yd. / Backing: 4 1/4 yd.



#### **Cutting Instruction**

#### From 6 medium colored fabrics:

Cut (5) 8 3/4" x 8 3/4" for the center of the block.

#### From 6 light colored fabrics:

Cut (4) 2" strips each. Cut (20) 2"x2" squares from each strip to make 80 squares. You need total of (480) squares.

Cut (2) 2 3/8" strips each. Cut (20) 2 3/8"x2 3/8" squares from these strips. You need total of (120) squares.

#### From 6 dark colored fabrics:

Cut (2) 2" strips each. Cut (20) 2"x2" squares from each strip to make 40 squares. You need total of (240) squares.

Cut (1) 2 3/4" strips each. Cut (20) 2 3/4"x2" rectangles from each strip. You need total of (120) squares.

Cut (2) 2 3/8" strips each. Cut (20) 2 3/8"x2 3/8" squares from these strips. You need total of (120) squares.

**Border:** Cut (8) 6" strips. Sew 2 together to make the length. you need (4) border strips.

**Binding:** Cut (8) 2 1/4" strips. Sew all strips together then fold in half and press.

#### <u>Assembling Instruction</u>

Finished block size: 11 1/4"x11 1/4"

- 1. To make a irregular flying geese, you need to place one light 2"x2" square on top, of the left side of dark 2"x2 3/4" rectangle facing right sides together. then sew diagonal line. Press open as shown on diagram and trim 2 bottom layers 1/4" from sewing line. Place another light 2"x2" square on the right side of the one you just sewed, then sew diagonal line. Press open and trim 2 bottom layers. (Set A)
- 2. Draw diagonal line on wrong side of light 23/8" × 2 3/8" squares. Place light and dark 23/8" × 2 3/8" squares right sides together. and sew 1/4" both sides of drawn line. Cut at the line, and press the seam towards dark side. Repeat this process to make (240) half square triangle sets. (Set B)
- **3.** Sew together in order of Set B, light 2"x2" square, Set A, light 2"x2" square, Set B. (See diagram) Make (120) sets. (Set C:60 sets) Separate these Set C in half and add two dark 2"x2" squares on both sides of Set C. (Set D:60 sets)
- **4.** Place dark 2"x2" square on one corner of 8 3/4"x8 3/4" large print square and sew diagonal line. Press open and trim the 2 bottom layers. Repeat on all corners. (Block E)
- **5.** Attach two Set C on left and right sides of Block E, then add Set D on top and bottom. Press the seam toward the center. Repeat this process to make (30) blocks.
- **6.** Sew blocks together as shown on the quilt (5x6 blocks).
- 7. 7 easure the top vertically (top to bottom) then prepare the border fabrics in that length and attach to left and right sides of quilt. Measure horizontally (left to right) then prepare the border fabrics in that length. Attach to top and bottom of the quilt to complete the quilt top. Press all the seams toward the border.
- 8. Quilt as you desired, and bind to finish the guilt.
