•	1 ¹ / ₄ yard fabric of your choice (backing)	•
•	COSMO Embroidery floss (see layouts for colors)

•	FOR EACH EMBROIDERY BLOCK: • From off-white fabric, cut one 4 ¹ / ₂ "x 4 ¹ / ₂ " square, & four 2 ¹ / ₂ "x 4 ¹ / ₂ " rectangles.	•
	 From assorted Durham prints, cut 24 2¹/₂"x 2¹/₂" squares. 	•
•	Repeat to make four embroidery blocks.	٠

•	 <u>BLOCK CONSTRUCTION:</u> • Assemble block together, as shown, pressing seams open. (Blocks should measure 12¹/₂"x 12¹/₂") 	•
•	 Using .01 Brown Micron Pigma pen or fine point pencil, transfer embroidery lines, using a light box - or window. 	
•	• Embroider, using 2 strands of COSMO Embroidery floss. (See layouts for colors used.)	
•	Sashing:	•
	From both off-white fabric & Durham prints, cut twelve 3 ¹ / ₄ "x 3 ¹ / ₄ " squares (each).	•
	• On the back of each off-white square draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Place each	•
•	off-white 3 ¹ / ₄ "x 3 ¹ / ₄ " square on top of each print 3 ¹ / ₄ "x 3 ¹ / ₄ " square, right sides together, stitching	٠
•	 a scant ¼" on each side of diagonal line, as shown. Cut along diagonal line of each square and press seams open, creating 24 - ½ square triangles. 	٠

•	OUTER BORDER: • From assorted Durham prints, cut 128 2 ¹ / ₂ "x 2 ¹ / ₂ " squares.	•
•	• Sew 2 ¹ / ₂ "x 2 ¹ / ₂ " squares into sets of two. Press seams open. Repeat to make 64 square sets.	
٠	• To make side border sections, sew together 14 square sets together - side by side. Repeat to make two side border sections.	
•	Press seams open & sew to each side of quilt center.To make top & bottom border sections, sew together 18 square sets together - side by side. Repeat to make two top & bottom border	•
