YARDAGE REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CHECKERBOARD BLOCKS-

- fat eighth (9"x 22") each of three assorted pink prints 9618 P, 9621 P, 9622 P
 fat eighth (9"x 22") of four assorted blue prints 9619 L, 9621 L, 9622 L, 9623 L
 fat eighth (9"x 22") of four assorted green prints 9618 G, 9619 G, 9622 G, 9623 G
- 1¼ yard off-white fabric (#550 1000 Colors Collection)

FOR SETTING BLOCKS-

- ¾ yard white main floral 9618 W (for outer blocks)
- 3/8 yard white oval floral 9619 W (for center blocks)

FOR SIDE BORDERS-

- 3/8 yard blue oval floral 9619 L
- 3/8 yard pink bouquet floral 9621 P

FOR TOP & BOTTOM BORDER-

 1¼ yard blue scallop border print 9620 L (inner white print will be used for side border)

FOR BORDER CORNERS-

- ¼ yard blue gingham 9624 L
- 5 yards fabric of your choice (backing)
- ½ yard blue fabric (for binding)

Borders:

BLUE SCALLOP BORDER FABRIC: • Trim off selvedges & from each selvedge edge, cut lengthwise an 8" strip (for a total of 2).

- From the remaining center white print of the border fabric, cut (lengthwise) four 3"x 45" strips for the outer side border strips. (If you wish - you can also cut the remaining white print into 3"x 22" strips & use along with the off-white strips for the checkerboard blocks.) From pink bouquet floral 9621 P, cut four (4) 3"strips.
- From blue oval floral 9619 L, cut four (4) 3"strips.
- From blue gingham 9624 L, cut four (4) 8"x 8" squares.


CHECKERBOARD BLOCKS:

- from pink fat-eighths, cut seven (7) (total) 3"x 22" strips
- from blue fat-eighths, cut six (6) (total) 3"x 22" strips
- from green fat-eighths, cut eight (8) (total) 3"x 22" strips
- from off-white fabric, cut twenty (20) 3"x 22" strips

SETTING BLOCKS:

- from white main floral 9618 W, cut six (6) 13"x 13" squares (used for the outer setting blocks)
 from white oval floral 9619 W, cut two (2) 13"x 13" squares (used for the center setting blocks)

- · For 'A' sets sew together pink, blue, green, off-white strips into sets as shown. Make a total of five (5) sets.
- For 'B' sets sew together pink, blue, green, off-white strips into sets as shown. Make a total of three (3) sets.
- Cut each of the sets ('A' & 'B') into seven (7) 3"x 13" units, as shown.
- Sew 'A' & 'B' units together as shown, changing the color placement as you wish. Repeat to make seven (7) checkeboard blocks. (Blocks should measure 13"x 13")



QUILT TOP CENTER ASSEMBLY:

 Following photo for placement sew checkerboard blocks & white floral setting blocks together into rows, & then sew rows together. Press seams open.

CHECKERBOARD INNER BORDER: (Using the remaining 'A' & 'B' units & four (4) 3" x 3" off-white squares)

- Sew togther 2 sets, as shown (3 of 'A' & 2 of 'B'), & sew to each side of the quilt center.
 Sew togther 2 sets, as shown (2 of 'A' & 1 of 'B'), & sew to each end a 3"x 3" off-white square. Sew to each the top & bottom of the quilt center.



Side Borders:

- From the pink, blue, & white side-border strips: For each color take the four (4) 3" strips & sew together end to end. Press seams. From this long strip, cut two 3"x 63" lengths. (Repeat for each color - pink, blue, & white.)
- Sew a white, pink, & blue strip together. Press seams. Repeat to make two (2) side borders.
- Following photo for placement, sew a side border section to each side of the quilt center. Press seams toward outer border.

Top & Bottom Border:

- . Trim the blue scallop sections to 43", & to each of the ends sew a 8"x 8" blue gingham square. Press seams toward scallop print.
- Referring tot the photo for placement, sew top & bottom scallop border section to the top & bottom of the quilt center.
- Layer, baste, & guilt as desired, & bind using seven (7) 2½" strips of blue print.
