### Floral Collection Josephine Rose

#### fabric Requirements:

Green floral (7234-G) 5/8 yard Blue floral (7234-L) 5/8 yard Green print (7238-G) 3/8 yard Beige print (7236-N) 1 5/8 yard Black and blue print (7235-CC) 1/2 yard Red floral (7234-R) 1 yard Cream floral (7234-E) 1 3/8 yard Red and cream print (7235-R) 3/4 yard for binding Blue toile (7237-L) 4 1/2 yard for backing



Cut 4 1/2" strips of the beige, red floral and green print. Sew a red floral strip to the top and bottom of a beige strip. Press seams, cross cut in to 12 1/2" x 4 1/2" sections. Repeat, sewing a beige strip to the top and bottom of the green print. You will need 24 red/beige units and 12 green/beige units. Use these to piece together 12 nine-patch blocks.

#### The star blocks:

Cut 26 4 7/8" squares from the green floral and beige fabric. Place a green square and a beige square, right sides together. Using a straight edge and a fabric safe pen, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Sew a 1/4" seam along each side of the marked line. Cut on drawn line and press, yielding 52 half square triangles.

Cut 26 5 1/4" squares of the beige, 52 of the blue floral and 26 of the black and blue print. Place a blue floral and a beige square, right sides together as in previous step to create two units. Repeat with the 26 black and blue print squares and 26 of the beige squares. Press blocks towards the blue floral fabric. Take the half square triangle units and cut on the opposite diagonal as shown. Place one of each unit, right sides together as shown. You will need 4 completed units for each star block.

For the center of the star blocks, cut 13 4 1/2" red floral squares, and 52 2 1/2" black and blue square print squares on two diagonal corners as shown. Trim a 1/4" seam allowance and press towards the red floral fabric. Piece block together as shown, yielding 13 star blocks. Refer to photograph for quilt top piecing. Sew 5 5-blocks rows, and then sew those rows together.

#### The border:

Cut the cream floral in to 4 1/2" strips for borders, piecing together to make necessary length. Sew to sides of quilt top, press, and sew strips to top and bottom of quilt top.
