Backing

Wof=width of fabric. HST=half square triangle. Seam Allowance is 1/4". Press in the direction of the arrows.

Cutting Requirements

Fabric A - 30856-10 Cream Monotone Santa

- (6) 3 1/2" x wof strips, recut and pieced into:
 - (2) 3 1/2" x 56 1/2" middle border sides
 - (2) 3 1/2" x 53 1/2" middle border top & bottom

Fabric B - 30856-11 Cream Santa

- (3) 2" x wof strips, recut and pieced into:
 - (15) 2 x 6 1/2" strips for log cabin blocks

Fabric C - 30856-70 Blue Santa (*30856-60 Green Santa*)

- (7) 5 1/2" x wof strips, recut into:
 - (2) 5 1/2" x 62 1/2" outer border sides
 - (2) 5 1/2" x 63 1/2" outer border top and bottom

Fabric D - 30856-80 Brown Santa

- (1) 3 7/8" x wof strip, recut into:
 - (8) 3 7/8" x 3 7/8" for log cabin blocks

Fabric E - 30857-10 Cream Monotone Print

- (5) 2 3/4" x wof strips, recut into:
 - (60) 2 3/4" squares for star blocks

Fabric F - 30857-11 Cream Print

- (1) 3 7/8" x wof strip, recut into:
 - (8) 3 7/8" x 3 7/8" for log cabin blocks

Fabric G - 30857-30 Red Print

- (5) 3 1/8" x wof strips, recut into:
 - (60) 3 1/8" squares for star blocks

Fabric H - 30857-70 Blue Print (*30857-60 Green Print*)

- (2) 2" x wof strips, recut into:
 - (15) 2" x 5" strips for log cabin blocks

Fabric I - 30857-80 Brown Print

- (4) 2" x wof strips, recut into:
 - (15) 2" x 9 1/2" strips for log cabin blocks

Fabric J - 30858-10 Cream Words

- (3) 2" x wof strips, recut into:

- (15) 2" x 8" strips for log cabin blocks

Fabric K - 30858-70 Blue Words (*30858-60 Green Words*)

- (2) 2 3/4" x wof strips, recut into:
 - (15) 2 3/4" squares for star blocks

Fabric L - 30858-80 Brown Words

- (3) 2" x wof strips, recut into:
 - (15) 2" x 8" strips for log cabin blocks

Fabric M - 30859-10 Cream Stars

- (3) 2 3/4" x wof strips, recut into:
 - (30) 2 3/4" squares for star blocks
- (4) 2" x wof strips, recut into:

- (15) 2 x 5" for log cabin blocks
- (15) 2 x 3 1/2" for log cabin blocks

Fabric N - 30859-30 Red Stars (*30859-80 Brown Stars*)

- (3) 3 1/8" x wof strips, recut into:
 - (30) 3 1/8" squares for star blocks

Fabric O - 30859-70 Blue Stars (*30859-60 Green Stars*)

- (2) 2 3/4" x wof strips, recut into:
 - (15) 2 3/4" squares for star blocks

Fabric P - 30860-10 Cream Trees

- (3) 3 1/8" x wof strips, recut into:
 - (30) 3 1/8" squares for star blocks

Fabric Q - 30860-30 Red Trees

- (7) 2 1/2" x wof strips pieced together end to end for binding

Fabric R - 30860-70 Blue Trees (*30860-60 Green Trees*)

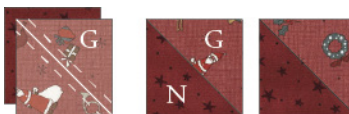
- (3) 2" x wof strips, recut into:
 - (15) 2" x 6 1/2" strips for log cabin blocks

Fabric S - 30860-80 Brown Trees

- (6) 1 1/2" x wof strips, recut and pieced into:
 - (2) 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" inner border side strips
 - (2) 1 1/2" x 47 1/2" inner border top and bottom strips

Star Blocks

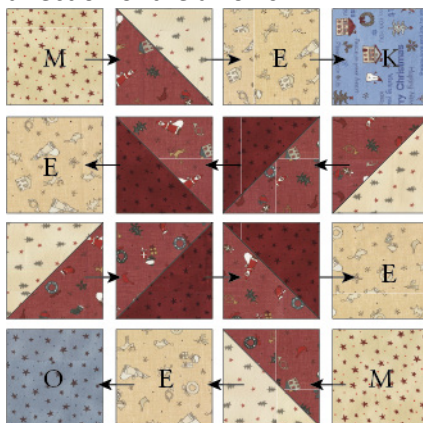
1. Draw a line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a $3 \frac{1}{8}$ " Fabric G square. Place, right sides together, on a $3 \frac{1}{8}$ " Fabric N square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the drawn line. Cut apart on the line. This makes (2) half square triangles. (The blue fabrics are shown.)



2. Repeat for a total of (4) half square triangles (HST).
3. Repeat this process to make (4) HST with (2) $3 \frac{1}{8}$ " Fabric G and Fabric P squares.



4. Arrange the HST units with (4) $2 \frac{3}{4}$ " squares of Fabric E, (2) Fabric M and (1) Fabric K and (1) Fabric O. Sew together in rows. Press in the direction of the arrows.



Make 15 blocks. They Measure $9 \frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.

Log Cabin Blocks

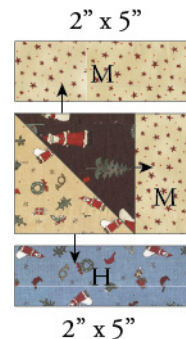
1. As described above, make (16) HST units with $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric D and Fabric F squares. You will only need 15 for the log cabin blocks.



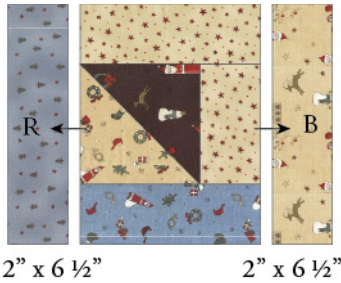
2. Sew a 2 " x $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric M strip to one of the HST



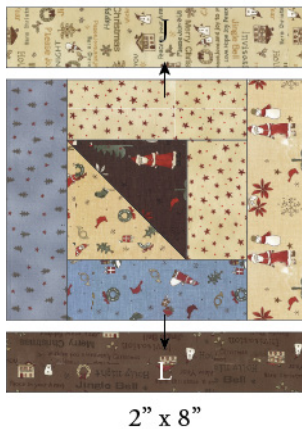
3. Sew a 2 " x 5 " Fabric M strip to the top
Sew a 2 " x 5 " Fabric H strip to the bottom



- Sew a 2" x 6 1/2" Fabric R Strip to the left
Sew a 2" x 6 1/2" Fabric B Strip to the right



- Sew a 2" x 8" Fabric J strip to the top
Sew a 2" x 8" Fabric L strip to the bottom



- Sew a 2" x 9 1/2" Fabric I strip to the left.



Make 15 Log Cabin Blocks. They Measure 9 1/2" unfinished.

Quilt Assembly

Arrange the blocks into six rows of five blocks each. Alternate pressing direction of the rows.

It is a good idea to measure your quilt top for border accuracy. Measure through the middle in both directions. Adjust border lengths as necessary.

Inner Border Fabric S

Sew side borders to each side of the quilt. Add the top and bottom strips. Press toward the border.

Middle Border Fabric A

Sew side borders to each side of the quilt. Add the top and bottom strips. Press toward the border.

Outer Border Fabric C

Sew side borders to each side of the quilt. Add the top and bottom strips. Press toward the border.

Layer, quilt and bind to complete your quilt!
