Cross Block Bars: 1/4 Yard Fabric # 70-96 C (Brown # 1)
Cross Block Accent Square & Sashing:
1/3 Yard Fabric # 70-96 R (Red #1)

Setting Block & Checkerboard Border Block:

1/2 Yard Fabric # 70-97 C (Brown # 2) 1/2 Yard Fabric # 70-98 C (Brown # 3)

Checkerboard Border Accent Block: 26 Assorted Fat Eighths and Scraps

Binding: 1/2 Yard Fabric # 70-98 R (Red #2) **Backing:** 1-1/3 Yards Fabric # 70-102 L **45" Wide Cotton Batting:** 1-1/4 Yards

CUTTING GUIDE

For Cross Blocks & Sashing From Fabric # 70-96 C (Brown # 1), Cut:

2 (1-1/2" x 44") Subcut 13 (1-1/2" x 6") 1 (2-1/2" x 44") Subcut 2 (2-1/2" x 22")

From Fabric # 70-96 R (Red # 1), Cut:

5 (1-1/2" x 44") From One Strip, Subcut 1 (1-1/2" x 22")

From EACH Of 13 Fabric Prints, Cut:

2 (2-1/2" x 6") Use Fabric #'s, (70-97 L, Y, G) (70-98 L, Y, P) (70-99 N, P, G, L) (70-101 G, L) (70-102 P)

For Setting Blocks & Checkerboard Border From Fabric # 70-97 C (Brown # 2), Cut:

1 (5-1/2" x 44") Subcut 6 (5-1/2" x 5-1/2") 2 (3-1/2" x 44") Subcut 24 (3-1/2" x 3-1/2")

From Fabric # 70-98 C (Brown # 3), Cut:

1 (5-1/2" x 44") Subcut 6 (5-1/2" x 5-1/2") 2 (3-1/2" x 44") Subcut 20 (3-1/2" x 3-1/2")

For Accent Blocks, Checkerboard Border From EACH Of 18 Fabric Prints, Cut:

2 (2-1/2" x 6") Use Fabric #'s, (70-95 PU, L, P) (70-96 G, Y, PU, L) (70-97 P) (70-98 G) (70-99 Y) (70-100 Y, G) (70-101 N, P) (70-102 L, PU, E, C)

From EACH Of 8 Fabric Prints, Cut:

1 (2-1/2" x 2-1/2") Use Fabric #'s, (70-95 N, G, Y) (70-96 P, S) (70-100 P, E, S)

For Binding & Backing

From Fabric # 70-98 R (Red # 2), Cut:


4 (3" x 44") Binding

From Fabric # 70-102 L, Cut:


1 (44" x 44") Backing

Directions

- 1. See Diagram A and make 13 cross blocks. *For Remaining Directions Refer to Diagram B*
- Sew 5 rows of 5 blocks together, alternating cross blocks with setting blocks.
 See Quilt Photo for fabric colors and placement.
- 3. Sew sashing to quilt top sides, top and bottom.
- For border sides, sew 2 rows of 9 blocks together, alternating dark & light colors.
 See Quilt Photo for fabric colors and placement. Make 2.
- 5. For border top and bottom, sew 2 rows of 13 blocks together, alternating dark & light colors. See Quilt Photo for fabric colors and placement. Make 2.
- Sew side borders to side sashings. Sew top and bottom borders to sashings and side borders.
- 7. Baste and quilt as desired. Sew binding strips to the sides, top and bottom. Bind the quilt.




Make 1 strip set for **each** Bloc Fabric Color for a total of 13.






Diagram B: Assembly
