Materials needed:

40 fat quarters

2 1/4 yards border and setting triangle fabric


3/4 yard binding


5 yards backing fabric




Cutting directions for each block:









- 1. Cut one 2 7/8" strip x 6" strip of dark fabric
- 3. Cut one 2 ½" x 7" strip of same medium or light fabric from above. Sub-cut into four 1 ¾" x 2 ½" rectangles.
- 4. Cut one 2 ½" x 5" strip of contrast fabric (either darker or lighter). Sub cut into four 1 ¼" x 2 ½" rectangles. Sew the two rectangles together following block diagram above. Press seam to darker fabric.
- 5. Cut one 2 1/2" center square
- Construct block as pictured above. Press top and bottom row seams toward center of block.
 Press center row seam to ward sides of block. Block should finish at 6".
- 7. Sew block-to-block in on-point layout. The quilt will require 111 blocks.
- 8. Cut two 5 1/8" squares. Cut on the diagonal once to yield 4 corner squares.
- 9. Cut four 9 3/4" squares. Cut corner to corner twice. You will use 14 triangle units in this quilt. To achieve the dark corner in the triangle unit, cut a 2/1/2" square from the dark fabrics used in the blocks. Place right angle edges of triangle even with 2 1/2" square fabric. Sew on the diagonal, following diagram below. Trim the dark fabric away and press the seam toward the outer triangle unit. Sew this unit to the end of each row. Sew the four corner squares from step 8 to each corner.
- 10. Cut eight 4" x width of fabric strips for outer border. Join two strips together to form each border piece. Sew to outer edges.
- 11. Bind and quilt.
