
## Requirements:

10" (25cm) of each of the following: 30392 (30, 20) 30394 (20, 30, 50) 30395 (30, 50) 30396 (20, 30, 50) 30397 (20, 30). 4yd (3.65m) white quilters muslin – cut nine of 21"x 21" and eight strips measuring  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x full width.

30" (75cm) 30392 (30) for border - cut eight strips measuring  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x full width, 20" (50cm) 30397 (30) for binding - cut eight strips measuring  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x full width. Fat  $\frac{1}{4}$  30394 (30) for circle centers.

### Instructions:

- cut eighteen times 15 degree Dresden wedges from each of twelve fabrics using a wedge template or shape pictured.
- 2. Fold each wedge in half, r.s.t. right along the length and sew together along the top raw edge only.
- 3. Trim corners and turn points r.s.o.
- 4. Sew nine sets of twenty-four wedges together using a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to create nine Dresden plates.
- 5. Appliqué a Dresden plate to the centre of each muslin square. Appliqué a circle to the centre of each Dresden plate.
- 6. Sew the nine muslin blocks together in three rows of three.
- 7. From red border fabric, create two strips measuring  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 62" and sew to each side of the quilt. Create two strips measuring  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 68" and sew to both the top and bottom of the quilt.
- 8. From quilters muslin border strips create two strips measuring  $4\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$  68" and sew to each side of the quilt. Create two strips measuring  $4\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$  76" and sew to both the top and bottom of the quilt.



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
