Fat quarters of the following Petit Fleur collection prints to make quarter square triangle blocks

30173-70 30177-70 30175-70 30179-60

½ yard cut of Petit Fleur 30174-11 for outer border & photo corners on stitchery

Fat quarter of 1000 Colors Collection 402 or other solid for stitchery background

1 1/3-yards backing fabric

Fusible webbing for photo corners

Fine point brown pig ma pen for tracing design

Cornflower blue & tumbleweed (tan) crayons for coloring in design

Basic sewing & embroidery supplies

Batting

Cosmo SeasonsCosmoCosmo Sparkles8502 blue167 blue76-3 blue

8039 taupe

Cutting Requirements:

Cut stitchery background fabric to measure 11½ X 16-inches

From each of the following prints cut eleven 5%-inch squares to make % square triangle blocks: 30173-70, 30175-70, 20177-70, 8, 20170-60

30177-70, & 30179-60

Fromborder fabric 30174-11 cut two strips measuring 2½ X 28-inches & two strips measuring 2½ X 36-inches

From border fabric cutfour photo corners *follow fusible manufacturers directions

General Stitchery Directions:

Center & trace stitchery design onto background fabric using your fine point brown pig ma pen

Coloring directions found on pattern page

Use 2 strands of Cosmo Seasons floss and backstitch entire design as follows:

basket 8039 taupe

all flowers & leaves 8502 blue

Use a single strand of Cosmo 167 blue to stitch button in center of bow, berries, & berry contour lines

Use a single strand of Cosmo Sparkle blue to stitch bow & vines

Constructing the ¼ square triangle blocks:

Match squares of 30173-70 to 30179-60 & squares of 30175-70 to 30177-70 with right sides together (rst)

Step 1:with each pair of squares draw a pencil line diagonally across square, this is your center line

Step 2:then draw another line ¼ inch on each side from the center line, these are your sewing lines

Step 3: sew along both sewing lines on ea. pair of squares, cut down center line & gently press open along seams

this creates ½ sq triangles

With rst match ½ sq triangles & repeat steps 1-3 to create ¼ square triangle blocks

You will need a total of 44 blocks: 22 from each color way

Piecing Wall hanging:

With ¼ square triangle blocks make two units that are 3 blocks wide & 2 blocks high each

Sew one of these units to the top & one to the bottom of your stitchery center block (this makes your center panel)

Next, with remaining ¼ square triangle blocks construct two units that are 8 blocks high & 2 blocks wide each


Sew one of these units to the left side of center panel & one to the right side of center panel


Followmanufacturer's directions for fusible & fuse photo corners to stitchery block corners just inside ¼ square triangle borders...blanket stitch in place

Next, sew borders to wall hanging in the following order: top & bottom first then sides

Finally you are ready to quiltas desired & bind
