YARDAGE & CUTTING:

Star Centers:

• 30 assorted $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

(excluding the gingham-dot prints, sample used one square from 20 prints, & two squares from five of the prints.)

<u>Star Points:</u> (sample used the six gingham-dot prints.)

- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard blue gingham dot (30553-70) Cut into four (4) $\frac{3}{2}$ " strips. From these strips, cut 40 $\frac{3}{2}$ " x $\frac{3}{2}$ " squares. $\frac{1}{2}$ yard green gingham dot (30553-60) Cut into four (4) $\frac{3}{2}$ " strips. From these strips, cut 48 $\frac{3}{2}$ " x $\frac{3}{2}$ " squares.
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard yellow gingham dot (30553-50) Cut into four (4) $\frac{3}{2}$ " strips. From these strips, cut 40 $\frac{3}{2}$ " x $\frac{3}{2}$ " squares.

- $\frac{1}{3}$ yard pink gingham dot (30553-20) Cut into three (3) $\frac{3}{2}$ " strips. From these strips, cut 36 $\frac{3}{2}$ " x $\frac{3}{2}$ " squares. $\frac{1}{2}$ yard red gingham dot (30553-30) Cut into four (4) $\frac{3}{2}$ " strips. From these strips, cut 44 $\frac{3}{2}$ " x $\frac{3}{2}$ " squares. $\frac{1}{3}$ yard stone grey gingham dot (30553-90) Cut into three (3) $\frac{3}{2}$ " strips. From these strips, cut 32 $\frac{3}{2}$ " x $\frac{3}{2}$ " squares.

Background: (sashing & setting sqaures)

• $4\frac{1}{2}$ yards. Cut nineteen (19) $8\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. From these strips, cut 42 $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " squares - for setting squares, & also cut 71 $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for sashing.

• 4¹/₄ yards (horizontal seam) or 5 yards (vertical seam) for backing • ⁵/₈ yard for binding

STAR POINTS - SASHING:

The stars for this quilt are made with the star points sewn into the sashing ends. You can make it as 'scrappy' as you wish or you can follow the quilt on the pattern front for your inspiration. (... where each star uses the same fabric for all of it's star points.)

- 1. Lay out your $4\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ " star center squares into six rows of five across, & assign eight $3\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{1}{2}$ " star point squares to each star center. (Sample used the same color of gingham-dot for each separate star.)
- 2. To make the star points, take a $3\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{1}{2}$ " star point square & sew diagonally on the left corner of one of the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " ends of a sashing rectangle. (diagram 1)
- 3. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " from stitching line, & press seam toward star point. (diagram 2)
- 4. Repeat the same on the right corner of the same $4\frac{1}{2}$ " end. (diagram 3)

QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY:

- 7. Following quilt layout on front, lay out star centers squares, star point sashings, & setting squares.
- 8. Sew together into rows (13 rows), pressing seams toward setting squares, & star center squares.
- Sew rows together, pressing seams open. 9.
- Ouilt & bind as desired.





(You will be making 49 center sashing units.)

6. For the outer sashing units (for star points facing the outer quilt edges) you will leave the opposite $4\frac{1}{2}$ " end of the sashing rectangle plain (no star points). These will be part of the outer edge of the quilt. You will be making 22 outside sashing units.
